

"Merged the energy of the Nile and the Ganges" ... an Indian wise woman reveals her secrets of attachment to Egypt in English

"A few weeks ago, Indian sage Sai Maa celebrated her 70th birthday at the Abydos temple in southern Egypt, and returned again this month for another visit to Egypt. She also has a consecutive travel program extending from 2023 to 2024. During her last visit, she 'merged the energy of the Nile River in Egypt and the Ganges River in India,' as she said in an exclusive interview with 'Al-Nahar Al-Arabi.'

The Indian sage, followed and mentored by more than two million people from India, the United States, and other countries around the world, is 'the first woman from the lineage of the Indian religious leader Vishnuswami (born in 600 BC) to be granted the title of Jagadguru in 2700 years.' The word 'Jagadguru' is used in Sanskrit to describe teachers or spiritual guides with deep knowledge of spirituality and Hindu philosophy.

Associates of Sai Maa and people she met in Egypt during her frequent visits indicate that her audience consists of people belonging to various religious and intellectual beliefs, as she provides them with pure wisdom wherever she finds it. They see her as 'drawing that wisdom from all spiritual and religious paths, whether through the teachings of God, or the principles of Buddhism and Hinduism, in addition to ancient civilizations.'

Human Tolerance:

In recent decades, Egypt has experienced widespread activity of political Islam and the penetration of extremist ideas into the roots of society, which has sown discord and blatant hatred against others in the hearts of not a few Egyptians.

The acceptance that the Indian sage has received here in Egypt during her recent consecutive visits indicates a striking breakdown in the waves of discord and hatred that extremist groups have managed to inject into the veins of Egyptian society. It may also indicate a trend in the Middle East as a whole towards human tolerance more than ever before.

Supporting this view are pioneering and promising experiences in the field of intellectual openness and acceptance of the other, led by regionally influential countries such as the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, and also Egypt, which is making clear efforts to renew the traditional religious discourse that formed the nucleus for the influence of these groups.

Ibrahim Nour, a specialist in Egyptology who accompanied the Indian sage as a guide and translator during one of her visits to Egypt, says, 'I am a devout Muslim, and I was quite concerned about the extent to which Sai Maa would touch on religious matters. It's a very sensitive issue in our Egyptian society, but when she spoke, I noticed that all attendees, who come from different social and educational backgrounds, listened to her attentively and happily. Her speech was wonderful, providing general advice and wisdom, without affecting our religious beliefs.'

As for Osama Azb Al-Huwaiti, a member of a family that has guarded the Abydos temple for successive generations and has preserved its secrets from generation to generation and accompanied Sai Maa on her recent trips, he says about her, 'She is very passionate about ancient Egyptian civilization, and understands the importance of its temples, and the cosmic energy gates in them, especially the Abydos temple. She is a kind and intelligent lady who respects our culture and religious beliefs.'"

Blending Energies

The Indian sage tells "Al-Nahar Al-Arabi": "My heart is full of deep dignity; this feeling possesses me when I contemplate the many journeys, over the years, in the beautiful land of Egypt. To me, it is a land vibrating with deep and active spiritual energies, a place where the connection between the sacred and the daily is tangible. The profound wisdom flowing through the ancient temples represents a great cosmic truth."

Although Sai Maa belongs to Eastern civilizations, she speaks in terms that may seem strange to the Arabic audience. She talks about astonishing and wondrous matters, saying: "Every time I am physically in Egypt, I engage in connecting and activating ancient Earth energies in preparation for a new era for humanity, a wonderful era of unity, communication, and awakening for an age of enlightenment."

Her talk becomes even more intriguing and strange when she says: "One day during this last trip, I took a small boat to the Nile and performed a specific task, which is blending the energies of the Nile with the Ganges River in India, through the Milky Way gate. The moment this work was completed, the call to prayer (through loudspeakers in mosques) reverberated along the banks of the Nile, in a divine symphony, invoking the glory of the one God."

"Important Years"

During 2023 and 2024, the pace of visits and trips that the Indian sage intends to make to Egypt, alone or with her students and admirers, some of whom come from America, Europe, Egypt and other Arab countries, has increased.

About the escalation of visits in these particular years, Sai Maa says: "These years are important for humanity. It is a period for deep healing, spiritual awareness, and spiritual awakening and transformation."

The Indian sage believes that "ancient Egyptian heritage offers a gateway for experiencing enlightenment in this new era. The trips have been designed as awakening journeys, using the cosmic energies present in Egypt, to guide those who are ready to deeper realms of awareness."

She adds: "Together, we walk the path that the ancients walked, connecting with their wisdom to aid in our collective spiritual development and awakening."

Civilization of the Ancients

Sai Maa is convinced that "ancient Egyptian architecture embodies cosmic truths. Temples and pyramids are not just structures, but expressions of sacred geometry, in harmony with cosmic energies. A high frequency, connected to the stars, activates a great healing power, located between the Milky Way and the Nile River."

She believes that these ancient Egyptian buildings "stand as symbols for the eternal quest for knowledge and spiritual harmony. They act as a mirror for our internal geometry, reflecting the deep relationship between the micro and macro worlds."

She describes ancient Egyptian civilization as "a shining beacon in our collective spiritual history. The ancient Egyptians understood the interconnectedness between all forms of life, the dance of energies, and the path to divine realization."

She states that "their knowledge of energy, spirituality, longevity, and healing was not just theoretical knowledge, but was living wisdom integrated into all aspects of daily life. Temples were places for healing, rituals were channels for divine energy, and art and architecture were expressions of cosmic harmony."

Sai Maa indicates that "this ancient wisdom continues to call us, offering us the keys to our healing and spiritual awakening. It is a legacy of love, a sacred gift to all humanity. We live in a great time of global awakening on this planet, where we rediscover the wisdom and energy of ancient civilizations and connect once again with the sacred lines of our beloved Earth."
